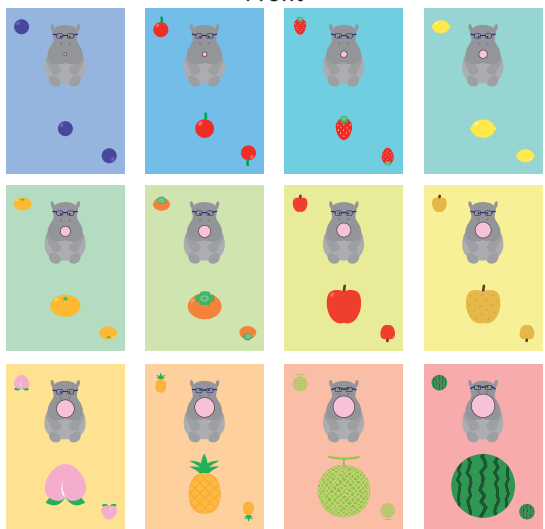

• Instruction Manual

① Story

In the hippos' village, today is the chief's birthday. Everyone brings fruit as a present. "Let's save the biggest pieces for last," they say. The hippos are excited to see what the others have. But if they get too noisy or wiggly, the chief might find out. Can they line up the fruit from smallest to biggest without letting him know?

② Objective

Players work together to arrange their fruit cards from smallest to largest. The only way to communicate a fruit's size is by "opening your mouth"; no other words or gestures are allowed. Arrange everyone's cards correctly in two of the three attempts to win.

③ Setting Up the Game

(1) Based on the players count, deal the fruit cards face down as follows.

Players	2	3	4	5	6
Cards per person	3	2	1	1	1

△ During the game, do not use words or gestures to reveal your hand or ask questions. You may only open your mouth.

The dealt cards form your hand and must be kept hidden from the other players; only you may look at them.

(2) Set aside the remaining fruit cards; they are not used in the game.

(3) Place all hippo cards face down, one by one, in the table.



When you open your mouth wide, make sure not to strain your jaw—just open it as far as you can comfortably!

④ Game Play

- (1) At the signal "Ready...KABAHHN!", each player opens their mouth to the size of the smallest fruit shown on their hand.
(If you have only one card, open your mouth to the size of the fruit on it.)

Fruit sizes are shown in the left-hand illustration; on the outer box, the fruits are arranged clockwise from smallest to largest.

Players often need to check the fruits' size order during play, so keep this page or the outer box visible to everyone.

- (2) Everyone discusses whose fruit is smallest. During the discussion, players may only open their mouths; no other gestures or words may be used to describe size or ask questions.

Keeping your mouth open the whole time can be tiring, so feel free to close it and rest while discussing. You may also say things like "Show me again" or discuss turn order, such as "Am I next?" or "Is your turn next?"

- (3) The player who thinks their fruit is smallest places that fruit card face down in the table.
- (4) If the player who placed a fruit card still has cards in hand, they open their mouth to match the size of their next smallest fruit. If they have no cards left, they do not need to keep their mouth open.
- (5) Everyone discusses whose fruit is the next smallest. Players who don't have any cards in their hand can also join the discussion.

Small

- (6) The player who thinks their fruit is next smallest places the card face down beside the smallest fruit card on the table.
- (7) Repeat until all fruit cards are face down from smallest to largest. When everyone has laid out all their cards, the challenge is over. (Steps (1) through (7) make up one challenge.)
- (8) Turn over all the fruit cards. If they are in ascending order, you succeed and turn over one hippo card on the table. If even one card is out of order, you fail and leave the hippo card as it is.
- (9) Shuffle the fruit cards and move on to the next challenge.

⑤ Ending the Game

The game ends after the third challenge. If two hippo cards are face up, you clear the game; if all three are face up, you achieve a perfect clear.

★ Hard Mode (for 3~7 players)

For each challenge, choose one player as the dealer. Deal no fruit cards to the dealer; instead, deal them to the other players as in the standard rules. Each player holds their smallest fruit card and opens their mouth. The dealer then chooses and arranges all the cards from smallest to largest—no discussion allowed! Succeed in two of three attempts to clear the challenge, or in all three to become a KABAHHN Master!
